## 2019 HIGHLIGHTS

#### **New Community Foundation Funds**

In 2019, twelve new funds were added to the Foundation. These included many different types of funds: designated, scholarship, donor advised, and field of interest. We celebrate the continued good being spread in our community through donor generosity. These funds will make impacts for years to come.

#### Rebranding

In July a party was thrown to reveal the new look and name of the Foundation. The former title of The Community Foundation Serving Greeley and Weld County was changed to Weld Community Foundation. The new name came with a new logo, messaging, website, a podcast launch, and the new slogan of "spread the good."

#### Surpassing \$30 Million in Assets

Thanks to the generosity of our incredible donors and the foresight and leadership of the combined past 23 years, the Foundation celebrated surpassing the mark of \$30 million in total assets.

#### **Scholarships**

The Community Foundation awarded 125 scholarships in excess of \$275,000 to students from Weld County and other schools. Scholarships were awarded from more than 39 different funds.

#### **#SpreadtheGoodlikeSanta Campaign**

The Foundation wrote a letter to our donors before the Holiday Season asking to support us with our annual year-end appeal. But this time the donations were not to be for administrative expenses. Instead, year-end gifts were used to fulfill some wish-list hopes of local nonprofits. 16 different nonprofits received gifts totaling more than \$10.000.


