ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY

Privacy Policy – Weld Community Foundation

At the Weld Community Foundation (the Foundation), maintaining the trust that you have placed in us is our highest priority. We have developed the following Privacy Policy to assure you that we have taken prudent measures to serve you to the best of our ability, while simultaneously safeguarding your personal information. The Foundation does not sell, rent, loan, or otherwise share (except as disclosed below) any information about our donors or users of this web site. This Privacy Policy applies to the Weld Community Foundation web site and governs data collection and usage. By using this web site, you signify your agreement to the terms of our privacy policy.

Because certain information about you, your organization, or your charitable activities is necessary to administer and service you online, we obtain nonpublic personal information about you from information that you provide on registrations, applications and related forms, and from transactions in which you participate.

We may disclose some or all of the nonpublic personal information described above to independent contractors and service providers but only for the purposes of servicing and administering of your activities with the Foundation. Our agreements with these service providers contain confidentiality provisions and restrictions on using this information for any other purposes. We may also disclose certain information as required under applicable law, for example, to government agencies. We do not disclose nonpublic personal information about you to anyone for the purpose of marketing or soliciting products or services.

Information collected:

Your Information: In the course of using the web site, the Foundation may ask you to provide certain information, including contact information, such as your name, address, and e-mail address; you may be asked to complete a registration form or application and provide personally identifiable information; you may also be asked to choose a user ID and password in order to take advantage of certain features of the web site (Nonprofit Directory). Participation in registration is voluntary and you will have the opportunity to decide whether or not to disclose information to the web site.

Site Usage Information: Whenever you use this web site, certain types of internet usage information may be received and stored; information from your browser, including your IP address, pages visited, the length of time you spend on the site, and files you download are recorded in the web site server logs. However, no personal information is collected during the tracking process.

Use of Information:

The Foundation collects and uses your personal information to operate the Foundation web site and deliver the services you have requested. The Foundation also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other services available from the Foundation.

Links to other web sites:

As a service to our constituency, we provide links on our site to other non-Foundation sites. We are not responsible for the information found on their sites, or the security of those sites. We urge you to review the privacy policies of each of the linked Web sites you visit before you provide them with any personally identifiable information.

Security of your Personal Information:

The Foundation secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. The Foundation secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

Security of Credit Card Transactions:

The Foundation uses carefully selected service providers to process credit card transactions on our behalf. When you provide credit card information through this site, your information goes directly from your computer to a server operated by our service provider.

Our service provider uses your credit card information only to process your transaction and is bound by contract to treat all of your personal information as confidential. Although our service providers send us the information you provide when you complete a transaction (so that we know, for example, who has made a contribution and how to contact them), for your security, our service providers does not share your credit card number with us.

Changes to this Statement:

The Foundation will occasionally update this Privacy Policy to reflect organization and customer feedback. The practices and policies contained in this disclosure supersede all previous notices or statements with respect to the same subject matter. The Foundation encourages you to periodically review this Policy to be informed of how the Foundation is protecting your information.
